


Let's start in the middle and work down to a good starting point



Precincts

- The smallest building blocks for all political entities (except CABQ boundaries)
- 441 precincts in Bernalillo County
- Range in size from about 12 city blocks to about 40 square miles
- 42 to 1270 Democrats per precinct, with an average of 446
- Apportionment:
 - At least one CCC member (the Precinct Chair) from each precinct
 - 2/3 of the precincts will have at least one additional CCC member

Wards

- Strictly a party entity, usually (but not always) based on State Rep Districts
- 58 wards in Bernalillo County
- 2234 to 4965 Democrats per ward, with an average of about 3300
- 4 to 13 precincts per ward, with an average of about 7.6
- Apportionment: the ward chair is the only ward-level CCC member
